Avraham Mislomim (Abraham Weinberg) of Slonim; 1804-1883, founder of Slonim Hasidic dynasty in Belorussia. A scholarly tzadik, in his writings Avraham stressed the study of Torah for its own sake, prayer with intense devotion (deveikut), and love and fear of the Creator. During Avraham's lifetime, his grandson Noah immigrated to the Land of Israel and developed a Slonim Hasidic community in Tiberias which was supported by funds from Eastern Europe.
